NOTICE TO ENTRANTS

ALL PERSONS WHO TAKE PART IN RMYC SAILING DIVISION EVENTS PLEASE TAKE NOTICE

Participation in sailing events of any kind carries risks to your life and property.

By taking part in sailing events you accept these risks.

These risks include, but are not in any way restricted to:

1. Collision with other vessels, the shore, structures or objects in or near the water.
2. Falling from your vessel into the water.
3. Bad weather damaging or sinking your vessel.
4. Being struck, falling, subjected to fire, heat or chemical reaction or injured operating equipment on board the vessel or while embarking or disembarking from the vessel.

Before embarking all those participating in yachting events should ensure they are physically capable of meeting the demands presented by being on a sailing vessel and specifically:

1. Know that the required safety equipment meets the regulatory requirements of the Maritime Authority of NSW and the relevant category of safety equipment stipulated in the 2009-2012 YA Racing Rules of Sailing of the International Sailing Federation. (Available at boating stores or on request from the office of RMYC)
2. As a person on board a vessel you must satisfy yourself that the vessel is fully seaworthy and able to meet varying conditions expected and unexpected.
3. Know where safety equipment is stowed on the boat, how to retrieve it and how to use it.
4. Know that the hull, mast, rigging, sails, engine (if any) and all gear and fittings are secure and in good working order.
5. Know that the safety of the boat is your sole and inescapable responsibility and you must ensure that the vessel is fully found; thoroughly seaworthy and manned by experienced crew who are all physically fit to face bad weather and all eventualities on the water.

The Royal Motor Yacht Club, Broken Bay does not, in any way, accept responsibility for the safety of any person, their vessel or their property who participate in sailing events organised by the club or its Divisions.

The responsibility to decide to participate in an event or race or to continue to participate or race is to be decided by those on board the vessel.

Any changes in hull, propeller, trim, spars, sails or sail area that may alter a boat's performance must be notified to the Handicapper in writing before the race effected by the change. (Refer Rule 32)

I have read and explained the contents of this form to all persons participating in the events subject of the attached entry form.

To ensure that everyone enjoys their sailing my crew and I will abide by the Code of Conduct outlined in the RMYC Sailing Instructions.
